DANCE KING – MR 89 (HMR 89) → 0-point drop

Last run: 3.60 lengths behind winner (70 days ago). Drawn 8, Craig Zackey rides — fresh after break, will need sharp return from wide draw.

WE ARE THE LOGANS – MR 90 (HMR 108) \rightarrow 18-point drop
